HEART TO HEART GRANT

2021 Grant Recipient: Duke University School of Nursing

Duke University School of Nursing will use the grant to fund their research project: Improving the Visibility of Women: Patients as Partners in Management of Uncontrolled Hypertension. This project will use a community-based intervention that will identify and reduce disparities and inequities among women with high blood pressure, resulting in an increase in the proportion of women with managed hypertension.
