Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is Founders' Day of Giving?

A: The Founders' Day of Giving 2021 is Alpha Phi's sixth day of giving. This is a membershipwide effort to inspire collegiate and alumnae members, to support Alpha Phi Foundation's mission by impacting the Alpha Phi in your life as well as women across the world.

Q: When is Founders' Day of Giving?

Founders' Day of Giving is Thursday, October 7, 2021. In honor of Alpha Phi's founding year, the day of giving is an 18-hour and 72-minute fundraising campaign. Join us on 10.07.21 starting at 6:00 AM Eastern Time through 10:12 PM Pacific Time!

Q: Where is my gift most needed?

A: Our area of greatest need is the Annual Fund, which allows us to allocate resources wherever the need is greatest. A gift to the Annual Fund supports the monumental *Leading* With Heart campaign, an effort to celebrate Alpha Phi's past and ensure the future for our sisters and women everywhere through three priority areas—Leadership, Scholarship, and Women's Heart Health. Your gift to the area of greatest need also supports Foundation programs like Forget Me Not Grants & Heritage, in addition to the people, facilities, and technology needed to make the greatest impact.

Q: How can I make my gift?

A: You can make your gift online, by phone, or through the mail. To make a gift online, visit https://alphaphifounders.blackbaud-sites.com on Thursday, October 7, 2021. If you prefer to make your gift over the phone, please call 847.475.4532. If you prefer to write a check, please make the check payable to Alpha Phi Foundation, date the check October 7, 2021, include Founders' Day of Giving in the memo line, and mail to Alpha Phi Foundation at 1930 Sherman Avenue, Evanston, IL 60201.

Q: Can I create a fundraising page?

A: Yes! Matching gifts made by your employer are a great way to make your generosity go the extra mile. To make a matching gift, please contact your employer's HR department.

Peer-to-peer Fundraising

What is peer-to-peer fundraising?

Peer-to-peer (P2P) fundraising relies on peers reaching out to each other on behalf of a cause. You've probably heard about crowdfunding. Well, P2P fundraising is a type of crowdfunding! In P2P fundraising, you are the megaphone that can speak to our mission! By sharing your story and fundraising page, you and your friends, family and community work together to support a cause near and dear to your heart, furthering your reach and making an even greater impact.

Why peer-to-peer fundraising?

We listened to your feedback and continue to grow and expand our reach. A part of this expansion is giving you, our most dedicated donors, a safe and easy way to raise money and support the programs you care so deeply about. Our P2P efforts could not be done without you!

SETTING UP YOUR FUNDRAISING PAGE

- 1. Visit the 2021 Founders' Day of Giving site at https://alphaphifounders.blackbaud-sites.com
- 2. Click on the Fundraise button
- 3. Select a Quadrant (Donations to your fundraising page will count towards this quadrant's total on the Quadrant Leaderboard - Click here to view the Alpha Phi Quadrant Map)
- 4. Create an JustGiving account with your preferred name, basic contact info, and password
- 5. Create your fundraising page by providing the following:
 - a. Fundraising page name (e.g. Class of 1872 Alpha Chapter Sisters)
 - b. Fundraising goal (You may edit this goal at any time)
 - c. Your date of birth
 - d. Select a fund to support (Area of Greatest Need)
 - e. Your primary address
- 6. Now that your page is created, you will want to personalize it and make it yours! Remember to get started by completing the following steps:
 - a. Upload a picture
 - b. Update your story
 - c. Share your page
 - d. Self-donate to get your fundraiser started

What to include in My Story

We recommend you personalize your page by sharing why you support Alpha Phi Foundation. Share your story of how Alpha Phi has impacted your life—through friendships, experiences, or Alpha Phi Foundation-funded programs (e.g. receiving a scholarship or attending a leadership institute). Your story can inspire others to give.

PEER-TO-PEER FUNDRAISING FAQ

Q: Do I need to raise a certain amount?

A: No, there is not a minimum or maximum amount you must raise. Any gift, no matter the size, can make a difference. This is your fundraiser and you set your own goals!

Q: Will there be graphics to use on my campaign and social media page?

A: Yes! They are available to download from the Founders' Day of Giving site <u>here</u>.

Q: Can I support a specific fund with my peer-to-peer fundraising page?

A: For 2021 Founders' Day of Giving efforts, all peer-to-peer fundraising pages will support the Area of Greatest Need.

Q: Can I set up a fundraising page to support a challenge?

A: Unfortunately, you are not able to create a fundraising page to support one of the Founders' Day of Giving Challenges. Instead, we encourage you to support a challenge by making a gift on 10/07/2021 to one of the 7 Challenges as well as create your fundraising page to support your favorite fund.

Q: How do I engage my supporters?

A: Share, share, and share! Share your page on social media, send our your own email blast, and call your Alpha Phi sisters, friends, and family. Use the communication templates in this guide for sample social media posts, emails, and talking points.

Q: Will I be able to thank supporters who donate to my page?

A: Yes! You will receive an email notification with each donation made to your page. You can thank your donors on your page or by sending them an email with the email address they provide.



PHONE CALLS

What better time to connect with your Alpha Phi sisters than in the weeks leading up to Founders' Day of Giving? Here are some talking points that may be helpful:

EMAILS

You can help build excitement by sending emails to your network. Here are some helpful tips:

- Many sisters read their email on a phone or mobile device, so keep it short and sweet!
- Sharing why YOU give is the most compelling story of all!
- Prefer to prepare your Day of Giving emails ahead of time? You can schedule emails in Gmail or by using the Delay Delivery option in Outlook. Test your messages so you know everything is working as planned.

Event Talking Points

2020-2021 ALPHA PHI IMPACT AND STATISTICS

Alpha Phi has had an incredible year growing membership and developing programs that will advance the lives of Alpha Phis today and into the future. Use the highlight reel below to help you celebrate everything Alpha Phi has accomplished recently.

- 2021 marks the 149th anniversary of Alpha Phi Fraternity's founding.
- Today, Alpha Phi has 173 active collegiate chapters.
- Alpha Phi's newest chapters are at Angelo State University and the University of Colorado Denver (CU Denver) — the first National Panhellenic Conference sorority at CU Denver!
- The end of the 2021 giving year kicked off the one-year countdown to the conclusion of Alpha Phi Foundation's *Leading With Heart* comprehensive campaign, a momumental \$38 million effort to grow leadership, scholarship, and women's heart health for generations to come.
- Alpha Phi Foundation supports five programs: Leadership, Scholarship, Women's Heart Health, Forget Me Not Grants, and Heritage.
- Last year, \$1.2M was invested in Alpha Phi leadership training and programs like the Alpha Phi Leadership Institute, Conversations That Mattie, Brave & Bold Dialogues, Leadership Launchpad, and more, that develop leaders with the skills and heart to influence positive change.
- Alpha Phi Foundation awarded \$466,800 in merit and need-based scholarships to 76 graduate and undergraduate Alpha Phis for the 2021-2022 academic year.
- Last year, more than \$162,000 was granted to the Heart to Heart Grant recipient and heart health organizations across North America.
- The 2021 Heart to Heart Grant was awarded to Duke University to implement a peerpartnership program to tackle hypertension and address inequities among women with high blood pressure in the Raleigh-Durham area.
- 51 sisters, collegians and alumnae, received the support of a Forget Me Not Grant last fiscal year.
- Alpha Phi Foundation provided a \$115,500 grant to digitize the captivating stories found in the Alpha Phi Quarterly dating back to 1888. Visit Alpha Phi's award-winning Digital History Site at https://alphaphi.historyit.com.
